




The Master of Arts in Peace and Conflict Studies program at Hacettepe University is a two-year program founded on the principle of developing cultures of peace and peace perspectives.

Your first year will be spent in Istanbul, where you will study with internationally renowned professors with invaluable knowledge and expertise in the field. Students will develop the knowledge and practical skills necessary to effectively analyze and evaluate the theories and practices of peacebuilding, while gaining an in-depth understanding of violent, destructive conflicts in the world. Your time in Istanbul will provide you with the opportunity to visit various official places like ministries, government offices, NGOs, and think tanks, while having the opportunity to get an intimate perspective on the historic and nonviolent social change movement that is currently taking place.
















After completion of your coursework, you will depart and spend the second year writing your MA thesis and preparing for its defense under the guidance of your thesis advisor. All course and thesis work will be taught and supervised by a group of highly credentialed international peace experts who bring years of dedication and expertise to trans-disciplinary processes of nonviolence and social transformation.

A certificate in Peace and Conflict Studies is also obtainable by completing one semester of coursework and submission of requisite papers. Students of the certificate program may enter the program at the start of any semester.

WHAT WILL IT COST?

MA Program Fees and Living Expenses

The full cost of the program is 11,500 EURO

Cost Breakdown: 6,500 EURO for Instructional Fees.

5,000 EURO for Lodging and Partial Board

Travel to Istanbul and additional monthly living expenses are the student's responsibility.

A non-refundable deposit of 1.000 EURO is due upon your acceptance into the programme, and secures your place. The balance of program fees are due upon your arrival in Turkey.

REQUIREMENTS AND HOW TO APPLY

The deadline for application to the Fall 2013 Semester is September 01, 2013.

Applicants must hold a 4-year bachelors degree from an accredited institution and have fluency in English and provide proof of it with TOEFL-lbt 70 or IELTS (AC) 6 (excluding native English speakers). In order to apply, students must send a copy of their transcript, a detailed CV, and proof of English fluency along with a completed application form. If necessary, we will conduct online interviews with applicants.

For Turkish applicants for proof of fluency in English, 75 from İDS or its equivalent in TOEFL-lbt (70) or IELTS (6) is required. They are also required to obtain 55 from ALES.

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
